Warner Basin Fish Passage and Habitat Improvement Initiative

Initiative Goal:

Recover Warner Sucker and restore Warner Lakes Redband Trout populations by improving fish passage and stream corridor habitat in the Warner Basin.

- Ongoing coordination with 35 water users in three irrigation districts
- Successful project record with completion of 10 fish passage and screening projects
- Secured Federal partner match funding of ~300K, and up to \$2.6m from Open Rivers Fund
- Improved fish access to 30+ miles of high quality habitat
- Collaborate with rural communities to preserve working landscapes
